20 hours Dual Instruction @ \$55.00/hour . . . . .	\$1,100.00
10 hours Ground Instruction @ \$55.00/hour. . . . .	\$ 550.00
6 hours of Pre & Post Instruction @ 55.00/hour. . . . .	\$ 330.00
Total. . . . .	\$5,935.43

NOTE: The national average for completion with a school such as ours is approximately 60 hours. Richmor’s average is 50 hours. (Learning aptitude and how frequently you fly will affect your total hours). A student should fly at least one hour per week to ensure good learning continuity and to stay within the 50 hour goal. Flight training is provided on a pay as you go basis unless prior credit arrangements have been made.
